**ORDER CONTINUING PRELIMINARY HEARINGS ON ATALAYA'S
AMENDED MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY AND OTHER MATTERS**

THIS CASE came before the Court on December 10, 2008, at 11:00 a.m. for preliminary hearing (the "**Hearing**"), on the (a) *Amended Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay* (the "**Atalaya Stay Motion**") (Doc. No. 104), filed by Atalaya Administrative LLC, as Agent, and Atalaya Funding II, LP (collectively "**Atalaya**") and the *Debtors' Response to Atalaya's Amended Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay* (the "**Response**") (Doc. No. 131) filed by Creative Loafing, Inc., CL Charlotte, Inc., Weekly Planet of Sarasota, Inc., Weekly Planet, Inc., Creative Loafing Atlanta, Inc., CL Chicago, Inc., CL Washington, Inc., Washington Free Weekly, Inc. and CL Birmingham, Inc. (collectively, the "**Debtors**"); (b) *Application for Order Authorizing Employment of Skyway Advisors, LLC as Financial Advisors for Debtors Nunc Pro Tunc to Petition Date* (Doc. No. 102) ("**Skyway Application**"); (c) *Washington Free Weekly's Motion for Authority to Assume and Amend Lease of Non-Residential Property* (Doc. No. 116)


(“**WFW Lease Motion**”) and *Objection to Washington Free Weekly’s Motion for Authority to Enter Into Amendment to Lease Agreement of Non-Residential Property* (Doc. No. 138) filed by Atalaya; and (d) *CL Chicago’s Motion for Authority to Enter Into Amendment to Lease Agreement of Non-Residential Property* (Doc. No. 132) (“**CL Chicago Lease Motion**”) and the *Objection to CL Chicago’s Motion for Authority to Enter into Amendment to Lease Agreement of Non-Residential Property* (Doc. No. 139) filed by Atalaya. Appearances were reflected on the record. For the reasons stated orally and recorded in open court that shall constitute the Court’s decision, the Court finds that all preliminary hearings should be continued until December 18, 2008 at 2:00 p.m. Therefore, it is

ORDERED:

1. The preliminary hearing on the Atalaya Stay Motion, Skyway Application, CL Chicago Lease Motion and WFW Lease Motion are hereby continued until **December 18, 2008 at 2:00 p.m.**

2. The automatic stay (and by separate order to be entered in Adv. Proc. No. 8:08-ap-00470, this Court’s *Order Granting Debtors’ Emergency Motion for Preliminary Injunction*, Adv. Doc. No. 9) shall continue in full force and effect pending the conclusion of the preliminary hearing on the Atalaya Stay Motion, unless otherwise ordered by this Court.
